
What is Florence ePrinter?

EHR records (e.g., laboratory results, clinic notes, concomitant meds list, etc.)



Web browsers records:

- BSA calculations
- EKG conversions
- EDC (e.g., eligibility assignment/verification)
- IWRS (e.g., IP logs, bottle/lot numbers)
- RECIST reports




Adobe or Microsoft (e.g., templates, SOPs, etc.)



Technical Requirements

Windows 10+ Operating System

Administrator privileges on computer



Active login/Role in Florence



Use your Florence username/password. No need for a separate account.



Permissions Needed to Print



View Binder



Import/Upload Document



View Documents Without PII



Replace a Document or Fill a Placeholder



First, install and setup Florence ePrinter™

- 1 Uninstall previous version, if applicable.
- Run "setup.exe" file as an Administ<mark>rator</mark>

Open provided zip file

6 Allow and follow installation wizard steps.

3 Save downloaded file.

Restart your computer (this is key!).

Extract Zipped Folder.

Pin printer to your taskbar.






Printing Creates Flattened PDFs






