Patients Indicate Interest from MyChart

Patients can update whether they want to be contacted about research opportunities directly from their MyChart account. They can indicate OK to Contact, Do Not Contact, or Undecided. If they're open to being contacted, they can create a research preference profile.



Run the Report to Identify Patients

1. Search for **My Active Patients Interested in Research Study Participation** Library tab of My Reports. Click the star to favorite the report.
2. Click **Run**.



3. Select the patients that you want to send MyChart recruitment messages.
4. Click **Send Recruitment Request** on the report toolbar.
5. Search for and select the study that you want to recruit the patient for.
6. Click **Accept**.



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What Patients will See

After a patient is identified as potentially eligible and a recruitment request is sent, the patient sees the request in MyChart, along with other studies they may be currently participating in. Research recruitment requests appear on the **Research Studies** page in the **My Medical Records** tab.

Patients can read a study description and indicate interest by clicking **I'm Interested** or **No, Thank You**.

If the patient clicks **I'm Interested**, they aren't enrolled right away. Instead, their status is set to a pre-defined pre-enrollment status, such as Interested.

Principal Investigator	Description
Physician Pulmonary, MD	Epic Medical Center Research Institute is conducting a study of a new treatment for people with chronic asthma. People who agree to participate are assigned randomly into one of two groups. One group will receive the medication under study, and one group will receive a placebo. The study involves 4 office visits over the course of a year to assess lung function as well as completion of short questionnaires. Participants are able to complete these via their MyChart patient portal.

Information collected for this study will be used to evaluate the effectiveness of the treatment for patients with chronic asthma and impact on well-being over time.
